



## Food Stamp Advocate

Volunteer with the Food Stamp Enrollment Campaign! In just two training sessions, we can teach you how to collect information from a client and make a preliminary determination of food stamp eligibility. We'll also equip you with the information necessary to assist the client in taking the next step—applying for food stamps. Once trained, we will find a convenient and supportive screening site (e.g. food cupboard, soup kitchen, health clinic, job readiness site, or our hotline) that will welcome you. We ask that volunteers are able to make a minimum weekly commitment of 2-3 hours for at least 3 months.

If you already volunteer at a feeding program or work at a social service agency, then you can take your new skills back there with you. Along with the services you are already providing, you'll be able to help those in need apply for food stamp benefits.

Attend two training sessions and be able to make a weekly commitment of 2-3 hours for at least 3 months.
